The program includes comprehensive and tailored academic, personal, and life-skills support to all scholars by providing:

- One-on-one coaching with a Blavin Campus Coach
- Mentoring with a dedicated member of University faculty or staff
- Educational Programming and Community Building
- Access to year-round housing



THE BLAVIN MISSION

Provide students who have experienced foster care with comprehensive support in navigating and maximizing their college experiences as they pursue a Bachelor's degree at the University of Michigan.

THE BLAVIN SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarship recipients are rewarded up to \$5,000 per year based on financial need.

Rewards can be renewed each year as long as the students file the FAFSA on time and maintain satisfactory academic progress.

REQUIREMENTS AND APPLICATION PROCESS

Michigan resident seeking an undergraduate degree who have spent time in foster care and demonstrate financial need should apply.

Applicants must:

- Complete the current year's FAFSA at www.fafsa.ed.gov
- Apply and be accepted to the University of Michigan

Recipients must:

- Maintain full-time student status and satisfactory academic progress
- Meet regularly with a Blavin Program coach
