The Fostering Futures Scholarship provides eligible young adults that have experienced foster care with scholarship funds for tuition, fees, room/board, books, and supplies/equipment required for enrollment.

The Fostering Futures Scholarship, a State of Michigan program\*, provides scholarships to young adults who have experienced foster care. The State of Michigan works with individuals, community organizations, and business to encourage charitable contributions that go towards Fostering Futures Scholarship funds.

Awards are paid directly to the students' institution to assist with unmet need in one or more of the following categories:

- Tuition/Fees
- Room/Board
- Books/Supplies

\* State of Michigan departments that are involved are the Michigan Department of Human Services (DHS) and the Michigan Department of Treasury-Student Scholarships and Grants (SSG) and Michigan Education Trust (MET).



## PROGRAM DETAILS

Student must have been in foster care on or after their 13th birthday. There is no upper age limit, students can receive funding at any age. Students must be attending a Michigan degree granting public or private 4-year college/university or a community college.
