What is MAGIC?



MAGIC stands for Mentorship, Access, and Guidance in College and serves students who have experienced or are currently experiencing foster care. MAGIC exists to increase the graduation rates among this population of students by removing barriers that interfere with academic success and the process of becoming an interdependent adult.

Through MAGIC, students have access to support and opportunities for leadership, engagement and networking experiences. Students also receive resources needed to develop skills applicable to campus and community life, in the form of workshops, professional mental health counseling, pantry access, housing support, group outings, navigating campus resources, and other developmental programs.

MAGIC will always respect your privacy and never share your information. MAGIC is sensitive to your individual experiences as a youth who experienced foster care and we recognize and respect your confidentiality.

What does MAGIC do?



MAGIC is all about providing opportunities for those who may not have them otherwise, due to uncontrollable circumstances. Aging out of the foster care system means homelessness for many, and MAGIC is on a mission to put a stop to that. Involvement in MAGIC provides a support network of people with similar experiences, opportunities for leadership and growth, educational and employment opportunities, social relief and financial support when available.

Who is eligible for MAGIC?
