The 7 Life Domains An Overview



- Casey Family Programs (2006) It's My Life Framework
- WMU adapted framework to include education at the center
- 7 domains framework offers a way to organize, understand, and develop a response to the complexity of lived experience.





The Education Domain

Major Takeaway: All life domains are interconnected.

Professionals and students agreed that success or challenges in all domains strongly impacts education. This emphasizes the importance of identifying and supporting strengths in each domain facilitating collaboration and expanding networks!

The Finances & Employment Domain

Major Takeaway: Finding creative solutions to help students navigate financial and employment resources is important!

Students agreed that potential financial barriers are a large concern in considering postsecondary access and success. This domain is easy to get stuck on and can be very stressful!

The Life Skills Domain

Major Takeaway: Students don't know what they don't know!

Life skills are the abilities we need to effectively navigate through every day living. Students need opportunities to learn *and practice* life skills. Take time to notice the skills each student has, name and describe those skills so the student can learn to generalize these skills to all areas of life.

The Identity Domain

Major Takeaway: An individual's personal, social, and cultural identities are **uniquely interconnected** and multifaceted, and are different for everyone!

Often youth are moved out of or through spaces that can help people define and construct their sense of self. The Identity Life Domain is very complex; it involves identification and definition of the various parts of oneself.

The Supportive Relationships and Community Connections Domain

Major Takeaway: Healthy connections are instrumental in promoting a sense of well-being and belonging.

We all need a community to support us and make us feel like we belong; these are the people we feel like we can turn to or fall back on when we are struggling. Taking risks to make connections is key to future success!

The Housing Domain

The Physical & Mental Health Domain


