Fostering Success Michigan



- Casey Family Programs (2006) *It's My Life* Framework
- WMU adapted framework to include education at the center
- 7 domains framework offers a way to organize, understand, and develop a response to the complexity of lived experience.





Supportive Relationships and Community Connections

- The experience of foster care disrupts relationships with an individual's family, friends, and community.
- Young people with experience in foster care may have difficulty establishing and maintaining supportive and consistent relationships.
- Relationships are often changing with new placements, schools, caregivers, and case workers

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Supportive Relationships and Community Connections Healthy, supportive relationships are a vital component of health and wellbeing and are instrumental in helping individuals succeed in all aspects of their lives.

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Networking is a necessity! Networking can lead to:


- Job opportunities
