

Michigan Financial Aid Checklist for Youth with Experience in Foster Care

STEP 1 — FAFSA

- Create FSA ID (your email + phone)
- Gather documents (SSN, ID, etc.)
- Complete FAFSA: https://studentaid.gov
- Mark "Yes" to foster care after age 13
- Upload DHHS-945 form if school asks
- Check FAFSA Submission Summary
- Respond to school requests fast

STEP 2 — MiSSG Account

- Create MiSSG account: https://missg.michigan.gov/students
- Confirm FAFSA is linked
- Check which MI programs you qualify for

- Fostering Futures Scholarship
- Michigan Achievement Scholarship
- Community College Guarantee
- Michigan Reconnect (25+)

Foster Youth Support

- FYIT (fees, supplies, needs)
- ETV Application https://mietv.samaritas.org
- Submit documents + receipts

NOTES:

Scholarships

- Check MI scholarship search tool
- Check college financial aid office
- Search major-based scholarships
- Avoid any scholarship that charges money

NOTES:

Before School Starts

- Accept/decline financial aid
- Submit housing documents
- Buy/rent textbooks
- Connect with campus support

NOTES:

During the School Year

- Check email weekly
- Renew FAFSA yearly
- Renew ETV if using
- Keep copies of documents

NOTES:
